WHAT IS AN EQUI CASH SHOW?

Unless indicated, all Classes will carry prize money.

Prize Money will be awarded provided there are more than 2 starters per class (not entries). In effect at that stage we then put £5 per entry into the prize fund for that particular class.

When there are 3 starters in a class then the first prize will be paid out which will be £10, and for instance there are 10 starters then the 1st prize will be £25 and we will also pay out a 2nd and 3rd prize.

The Prize Money grid and how it works is at the rear of this schedule.

At the time of printing there is no prize money allocated for Section, Ring and End of Day Champions, but there will be Trophies, Rosettes and sashes

TRAVELLING TO WOOD FARM

Wood Farm is situated off Gospel End Road (A463) approx 1 mile from Sedgley Town Centre and approx 1.5 miles from Wombourne

Approaching on the A449, when reaching the Wombourne Island, turn onto the A463 towards Sedgley, after approx 1.5 miles, you will pass the Summerhouse Pub on your left, the entrance to Wood Farm is past the next set of traffic lights and approx 50 mtrs further on your right from the lights

Approaching from Sedgley, turn onto the A463 in Sedgley Town Centre, after approx 400 mtrs, the Seven Stars pub is on your left, after another 600 mtrs the entrance to Wood Farm is on your left
